9. And drink?

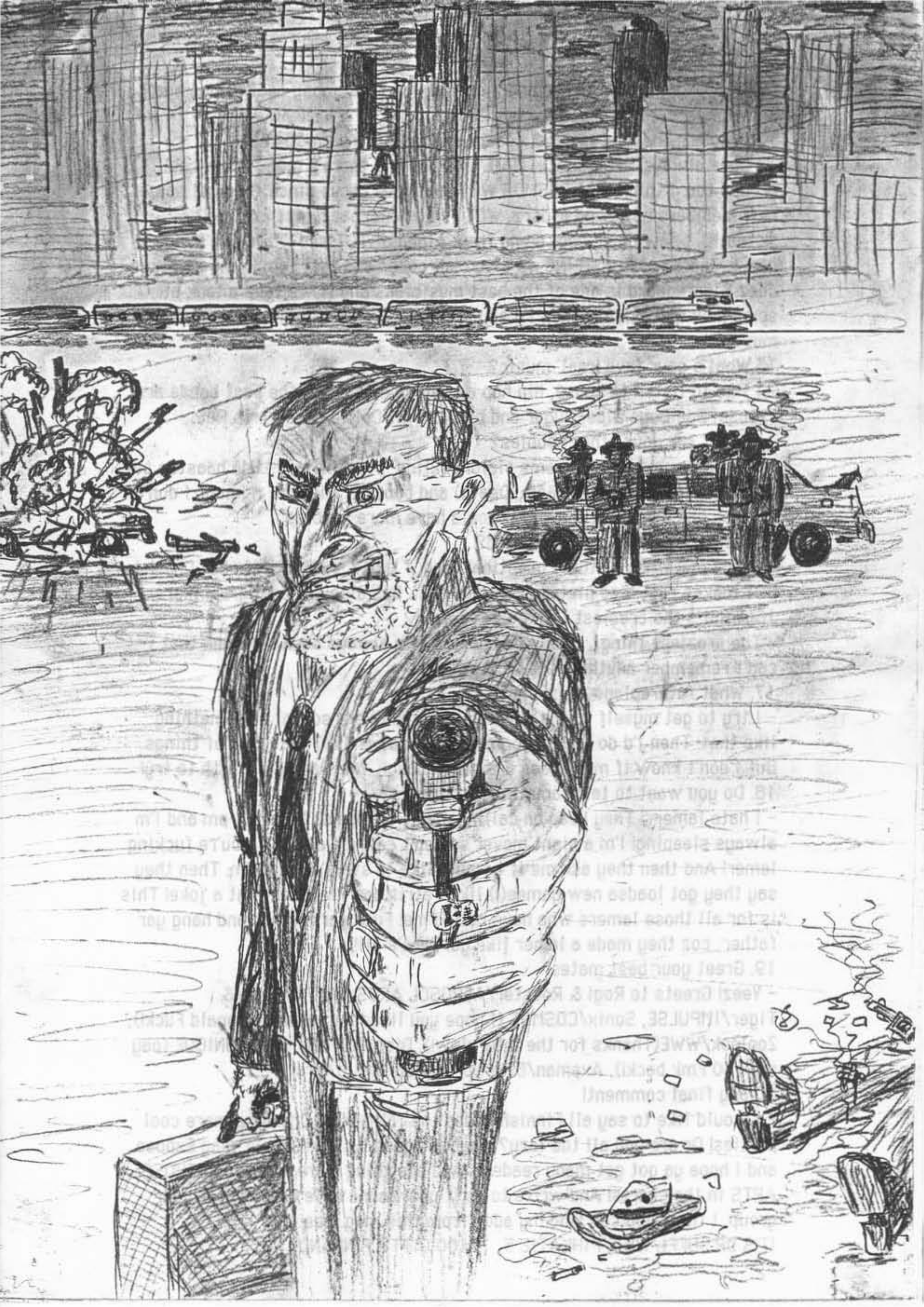
- I like beer very much (Heineken and Koff) but what would be the best coctail..I think Screwdriver is quite good.
